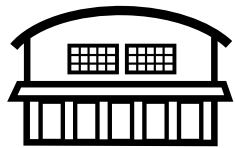

EASY PARKING PERMITS AVAILABLE

Make parking easy with a parking permit from The Forum Sports & Aquatic Centre, allowing you to park for two hours in car parks 9, 12 and 13. Free parking in car park 16 (train station). The permit is valid for one calendar year and conditions apply*. Valid parking permits required Monday – Friday 8.00am – 5.30pm all year round. At all other times, parking is free. The University's traffic and parking rules* apply at all times.

FREE PARKING

Free parking is available at Car Park 16, a short 2 minute walk to The Forum Sports & Aquatic Centre.

RIDING YOUR BIKE

A number of cycle paths are provided with direct links to the University from most parts of Newcastle. Bike racks are available directly outside The Forum Sports & Aquatic Centre. Please ensure you secure your bike appropriately as NUsport will not be held liable for any loss of property.

CATCHING A TRAIN

Alight at Warabrook (University) Station and follow pathways around ovals. For timetable information contact CityRail on 131 500 or visit www.cityrail.com

CATCHING THE BUS

Alight at the University 'Design' bus stop and follow Ring Road to The Forum Sports & Aquatic Centre (past the Tennis Courts). For timetable information contact Newcastle Buses on 131 500 or visit www.newcastlebuses.info

*UNIVERSITY TRAFFIC & PARKING RULES

Car parking conditions apply from 8.00 am - 5.30 pm weekdays, all year, even during University holidays. Please note that the University Campus is gazetted as a RESTRICTED PARKING AREA. Parking is permitted ONLY in marked bays at all times. Please read the signs carefully. Fines are collected by NSW Police - so please avoid the risk. Community (non-University) members of The Forum can purchase a Forum parking permit. The permit cannot be sold to students or staff members of the University of Newcastle.

The Forum parking permit and any day permits are not valid for Disabled, Reserved or Service Bays.

Holders of an RTA Mobility Permit are eligible for free parking in Disabled, Staff and General car parking spaces. The permit must be clearly displayed on the front left-hand side of the vehicle's windscreen at all times. Please note that RTA Mobility Parking Scheme conditions apply.

Permit holders should be advised that if a parking permit is lost, stolen or damaged it will need to be re-purchased in order to replace it.
